ADMISSION IN ST. STEPHEN'S COLLEGE, DELHI ON SELF FINANCING BASIS : 2021-22

Embassy of India, Kathmandu invites applications from Nepalese Nationals desirous of seeking admission in Under Graduate Courses in St. Stephen's College, Delhi for the academic year 2021-22.

2. Eligibility Criteria:

The candidates have to follow the eligibility criteria for admission mentioned on the website of St. Stephen's college and outlined in the college prospectus.

3. How to Apply:

- (i) The candidates will have to follow the application process for Foreign Candidates prescribed and outlined by the St. Stephen's college.
- (ii) After submitting the online application, the candidates have to submit hard copy of the application along with the enclosed Bio-data form (with all enclosures) to Education Wing, Embassy of India, Kathmandu. **The last date for submitting the application along with bio-data form is 15.07.2021.**

3. How to Submit the Application:

The following documents needs to be submitted by the candidates applying through Embassy of India, Kathmandu with the Bio-data form :

- (i) Complete bio-data form of applicant in English language with recent photograph pasted at prescribed place.
- (ii) Hard copy of the application submitted online by the candidate through the website of St. Stephen's College.
- (iii) Notary attested photocopy of Date of Birth certificate issued by Municipality.
- (iv) Conversion of marks in percentage (%) from the Principal/Head of Institution last attended in a tabulated format.
- (iv) Notary public attested copy of marks sheets of last examination passed.
- (v) Notary public attested photocopy of citizenship (in English transcript) of self, father & mother.
- (vi) Medical fitness certificate.

4. Please Note:

- (i) The applicants are advised that merely forwarding their application should not be treated as assurance for their selection. The Mission/Ministry will scrutinize all the applications and only after these are found complete in all respects will be processed and further forwarded to St. Stephen's College for consideration.
- (ii) Shortlisted candidates are expected to comply with admission formalities and procedures of the St. Stephen's College / University of Delhi.
- (iii) The seats under this scheme are on **Self-Finance Basis** and the Mission/Ministry does not provide any financial aid/scholarship to applicants selected under this scheme.
- (iv) The candidates should check the fee details at St. Stephen's College website/prospectus applicable for Foreign Students.
- (v) The candidates are advised to familiarize themselves with the procedures for online application and fee etc. through St. Stephen's College website/prospectus.
- (vi) Foreign students having PIO, OCI card and NRIs are not eligible to apply.
- (vii) Selected students will be expected to pay all applicable Fees for Foreign Students to the University of Delhi and St. Stephen's College, Delhi.
- (viii) The facility of hostel and mess will be directly provided by the College on availability-basis and will entail separate charges.
