

NOTICE FOR ADMISSION IN APS- 2018-19

Embassy of India, Kathmandu invites applications from Nepali students desirous of pursuing class VI to IX and XI in APS Pithoragarh (for boys & girls), APS Dhaulakuan (for boys only) and APS Noida (for girls only) during the academic year 2018-19. Application in form of Bio-data may be submitted with all relevant details-Student Name, Father's Name, Date of Birth, Age as on March 31, 2018, Last class passed, Name of School in which last class passed, Max. Marks/Marks obtained in last class, Postal Address, Mobile number, Email and recent photograph of candidate pasted in Bio-data.

2. The candidate should attach copies of Mark sheet of last class passed, age certificate, Nepali Citizenship document/passport (If not available copy of Nepali citizenship document/passport of both father & mother) and bank receipt voucher (original) of NRs. 400/-.
3. Short listed students have to compulsorily appear in English test/Interview. The dates would be communicated later.
4. The application fee of NRs.400/- should be deposited in favor of Education Wing, EOI, Kathmandu Account No. 17725240200331 of Nepal SBI, anywhere in Nepal, not later than February 16, 2018.
5. Application form can be submitted, **on or before February 16, 2018 (Friday)**, at one of the three places- (i) Consulate General of India, Biratnagar (Dhankuta, Ilam, Jhapa, Morang, Siraha, Saptari, Sunsari & Udaipur), (ii) Consulate General of India, Birgunj (Bara, Chitwan, Dhanusha, Mahottari, Makwanpur, Parsa, Rautahat & Sarlahi), (iii) Embassy of India, Kathmandu (other than districts mentioned above) before February 16, 2018. Application fee once deposited will not be refunded or adjusted.
